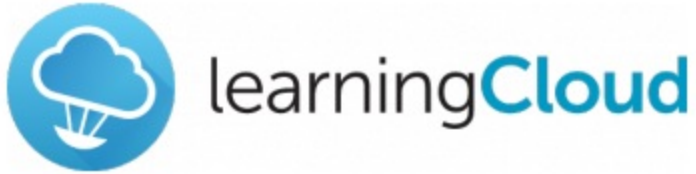

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1. Introduction (Mobile)

Thanks to **learningCloud Mobile**, you can carry your training with you and perform it whenever and wherever you want. Through this intuitive application for iOS and Android mobile devices and tablets, you can access your training.

Download your session, carry it with you and learn whenever you want. You do not need to be online to perform it: your tracking data is kept and sent to the server the next time you are back online.

2.1 For Android devices (Mobile)

To download the application, go to **Google Play**.

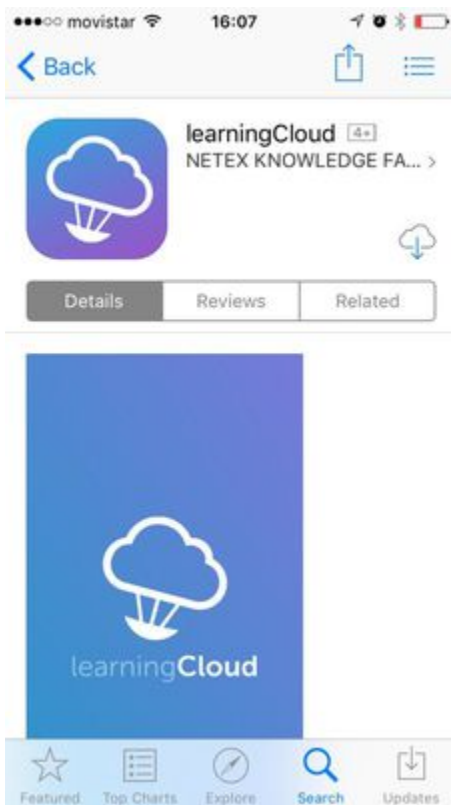
Search the application and click on **"Install"** to download it free of charge on your device.

To download the application, go to the **App Store**.

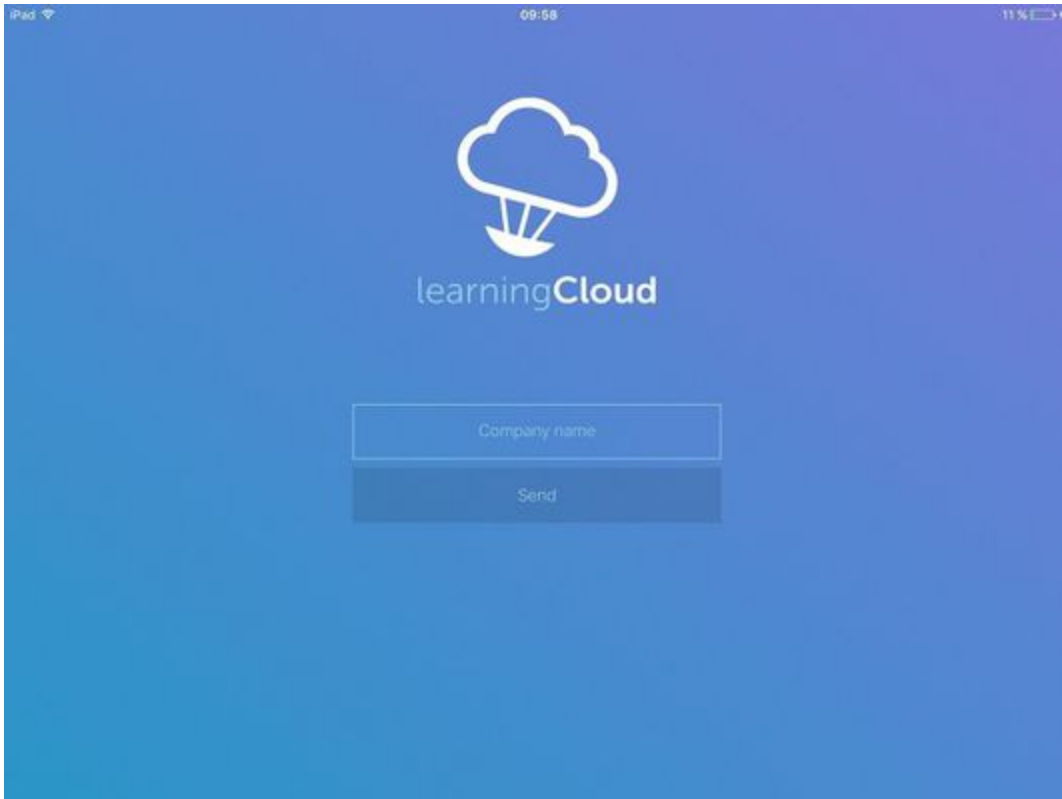

3.1 Accessing learningCloud Mobile (Mobile)

You need login credentials (company name, user and password) to access the application. You will receive an email with these credentials when you are registered in the system.



Once you enter the name of the company, the App will ask for a username and password.




If you do not remember your password, you can retrieve it by clicking on "***Have you forgotten your password?***". In this case, you have to enter your email address, and you will receive an email containing instructions for how to change your password.



SAML 2.0 authentication








learningCloud Mobile allows you to configure a **Single Sign On** system under the SAML 2.0 standard, by allowing the integration of an authentication system shared with other applications used by your company. If learningCloud Mobile has been configured to use this type of authentication, the steps to enter your credentials will be different. After entering the company name on the login screen, you will be sent to a page personalized for your company. On that page you must enter the username and password you normally use for other company applications.



3.2 Main Menu (Mobile)

Click the  icon to access the main menu. From the main menu, you can view your profile information and access the main training and configuration options.

3.3 Updating learningCloud Mobile (Mobile)

When there is a new version of the application available, the market (the **App Store** or **Google Play**) will send a notification to your device so that you can update it.

When there are critical application updates, you will receive a notification informing you that the installed version is an old one and you have to update it in order to avoid possible errors that might occur if you keep working with it.

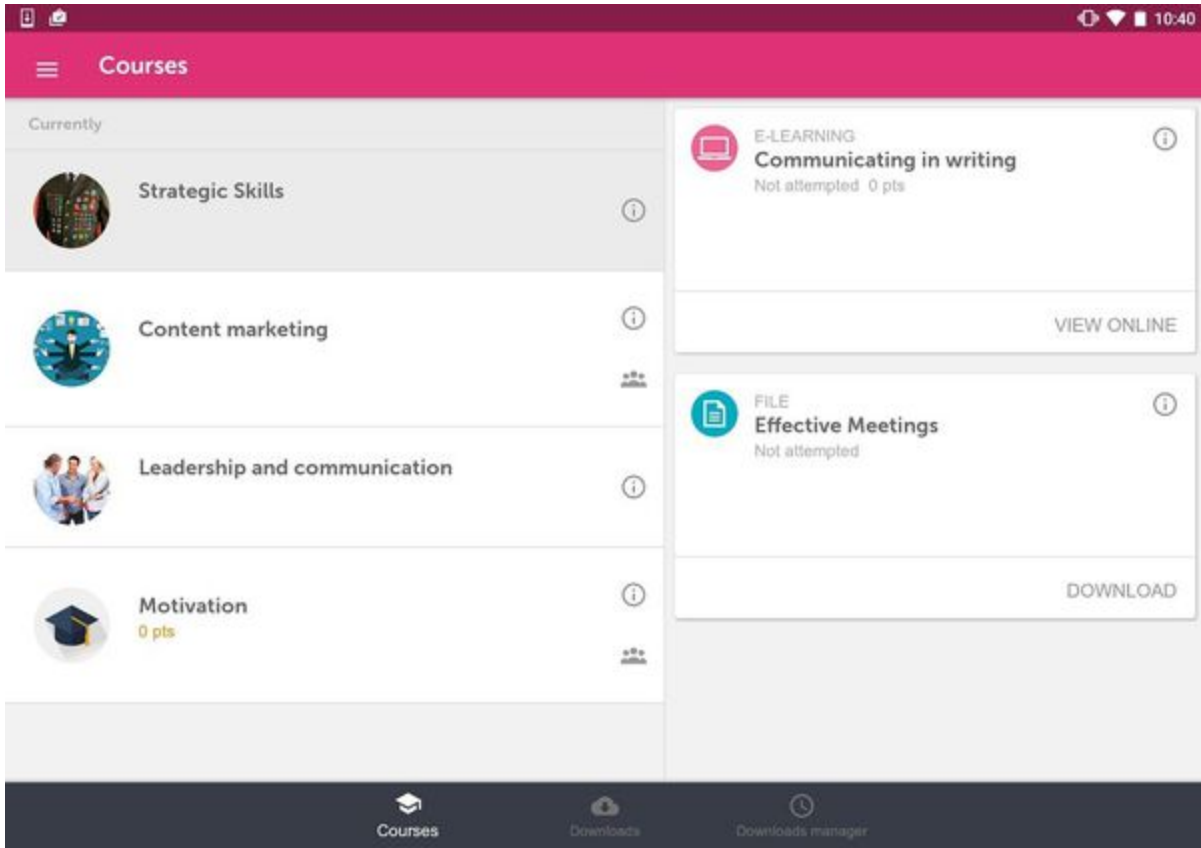

4.1 Courses (mobile)

The sessions are gather in courses. Access the course you are interested in to see all the sessions related to that topic.

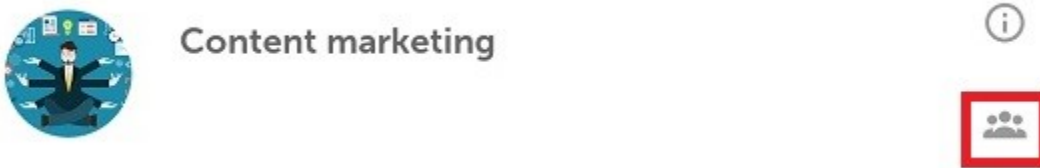
Courses will have different stages. The stage of the student in these course appeared with a particular colour code:

- **Not attempted (grey)**: when the start date of the course has not came yet.
- **In progress (orange)**: the course changes its status to "in progress" the same day it starts.
- **Passed (green)**: when a course is already completed with a equal or greater mark than the minimun required.
- **Failed (red)**: when a course is already completed with a lower mark than the minimun required.

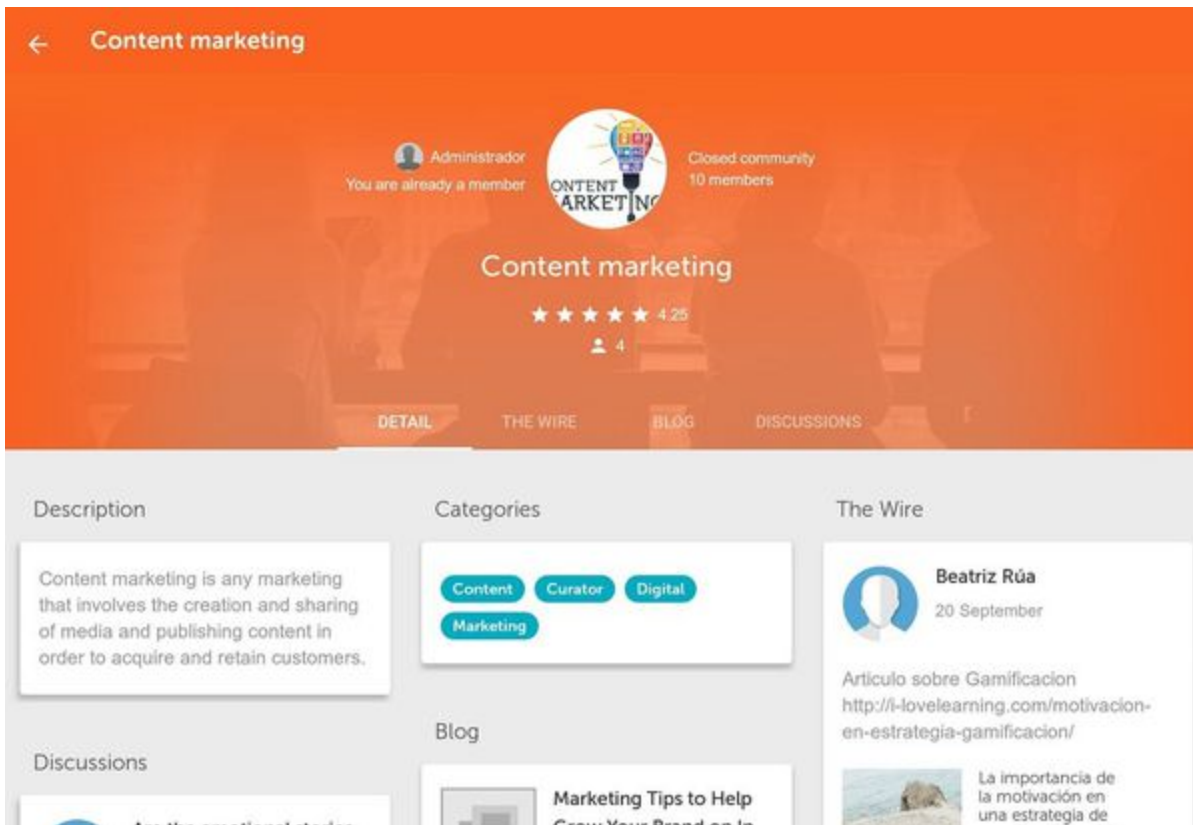


Accessing a Course Community

To access a course community, simply click the icon which indicates courses that offer communities.

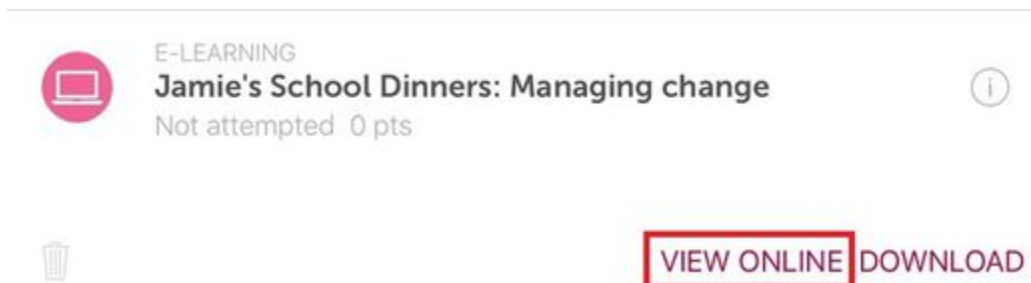


You will be able to access the course community to experience all of the of social and collaborative learning features that **learningCloud** provides



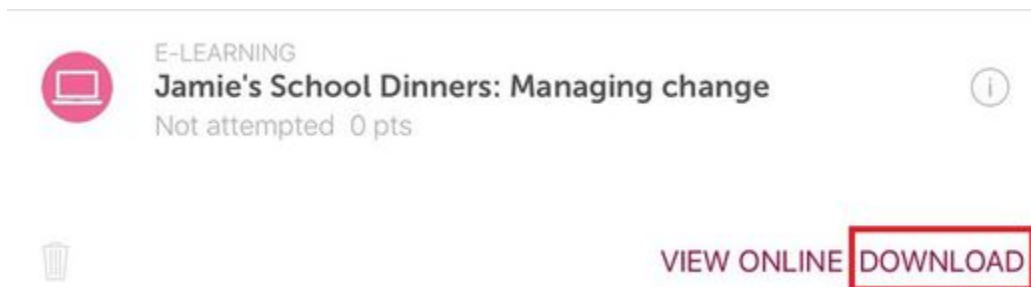

To download a session, click on **Download** and the session will be launched.



Downloading a session

To download a session, you only have to click on **Download**.

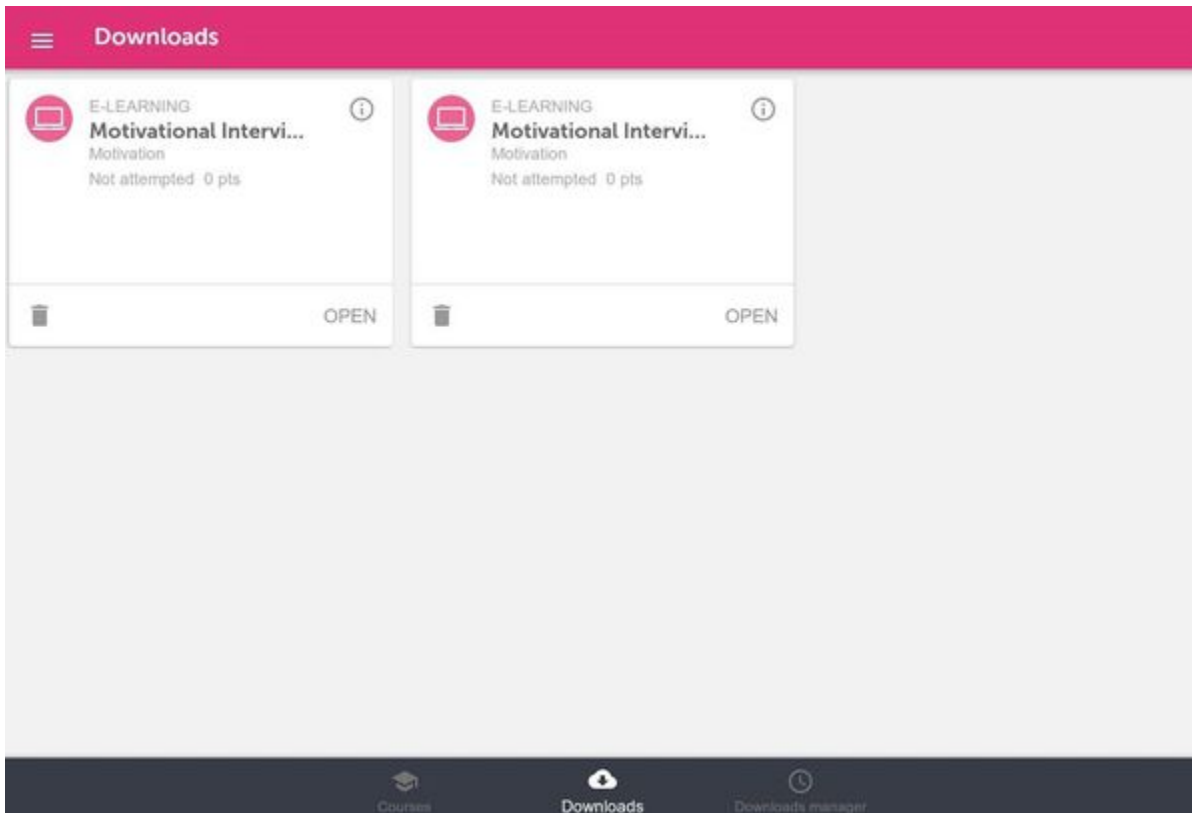


From **My training** screen, you can display the download progress of each session. You can stop the download progress anytime.

Once the session has been downloaded, you can open the session by clicking on *Open*.

4.2 Downloads (Mobile)


Downloads allows checking the status and progress of the downloaded sessions.



You can open the session by clicking on **Open**.

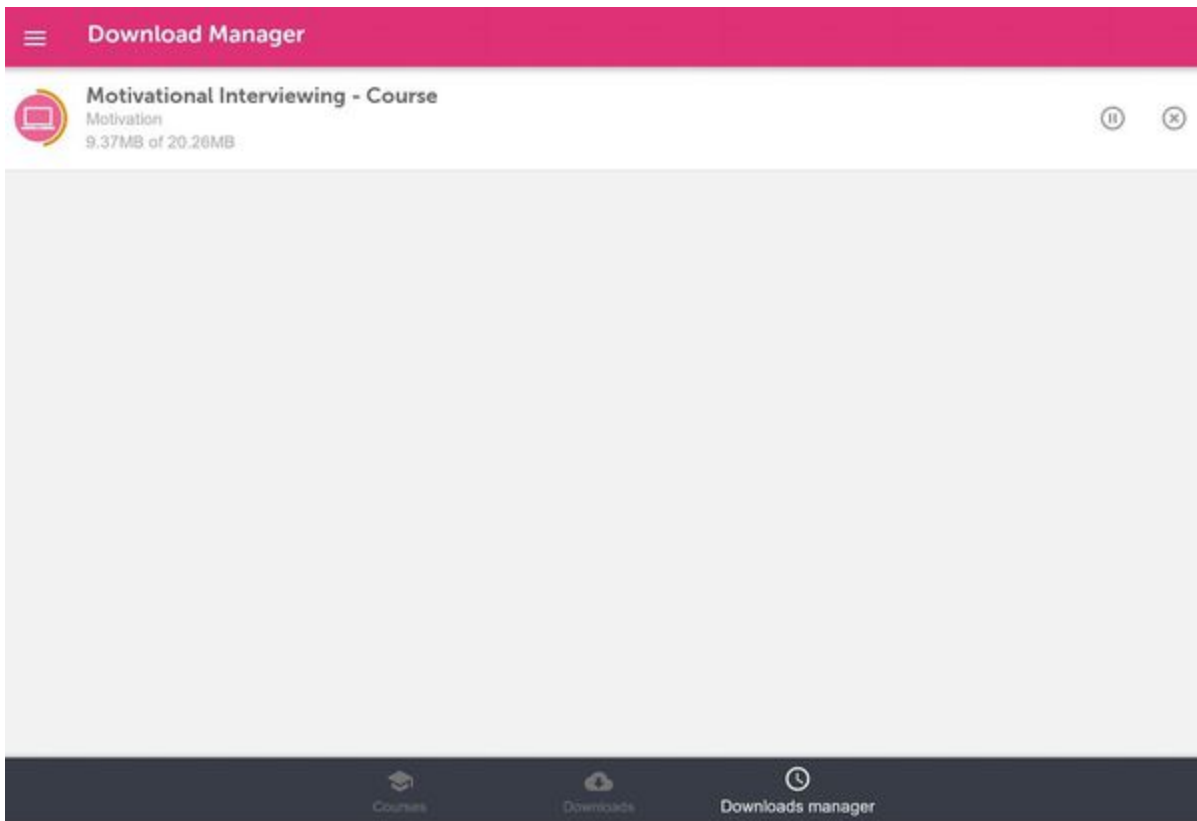
The training goes through several status:

- **Not attempted (grey)**: when the start date of the course has not come yet.
- **In progress (orange)**: the course changes its status to "in progress" the same day it starts.
- **Passed (green)**: when a course is already completed with a equal or greater mark than the minimum required.
- **Failed (red)**: when a course is already completed with a lower mark than the minimum required.

If you have completed a session and you do not want to keep it on the device, click on  to delete the file.

4.3 Download manager (Mobile)

From the **Download manager** section, you can display the sessions that are being downloaded.



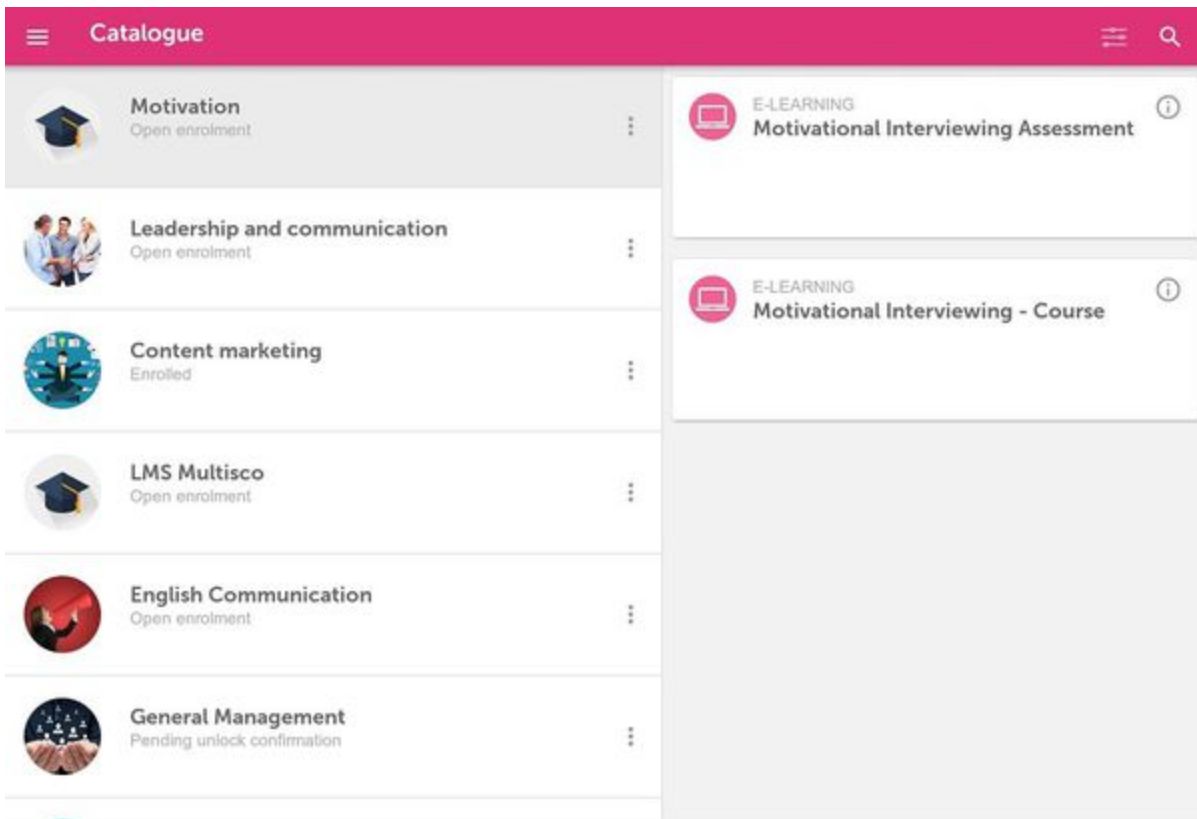

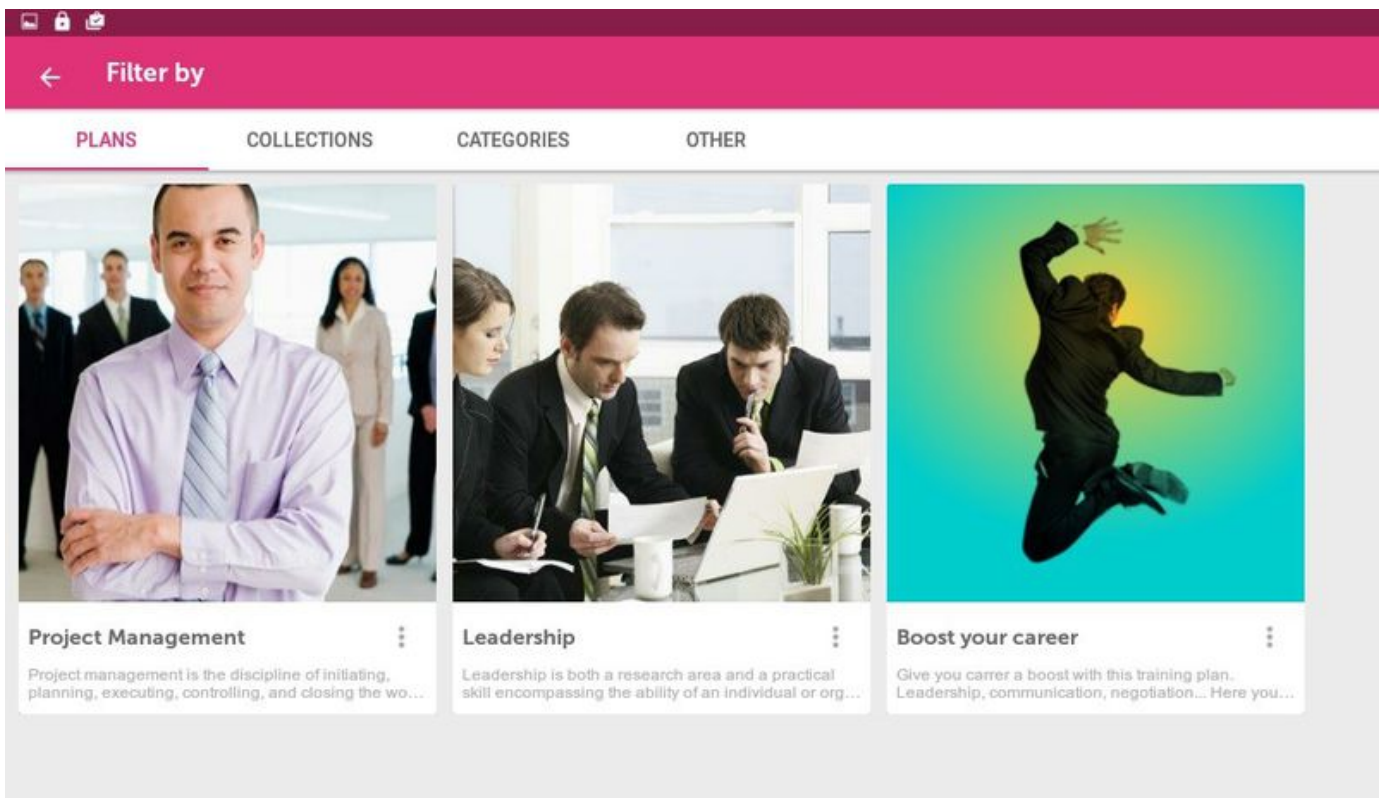

5.1 Catalogue (Mobile)

Accessing **Catalogue**, you will display the available courses included. Also, you can view the details of a specific course before enrolling in it.





The Catalogue filters  allow setting a filter in the **Catalogue** titles list.



You can filter by plans, collections, categories or courses in which you are not enrolled. Also, according with the course enrolment policy (free access or enrolment request).

View course and sessions information

By clicking on the icon  in the course, you will view a menu that provides access to the course information.

To access the training information, click on the icon  .

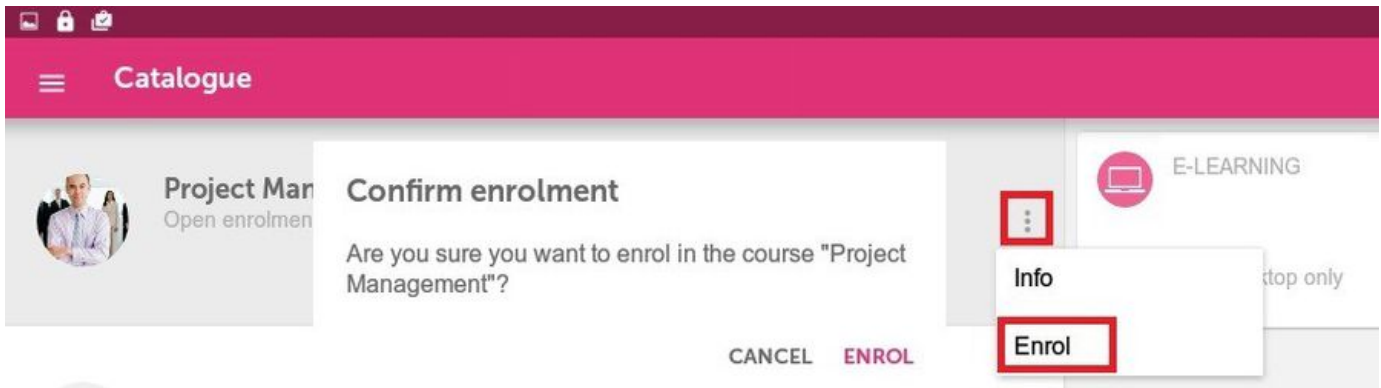

The information includes the **Excerpt, Objectives, starting and end dates**. There are also labels that identify the collection of the course and the assigned category.

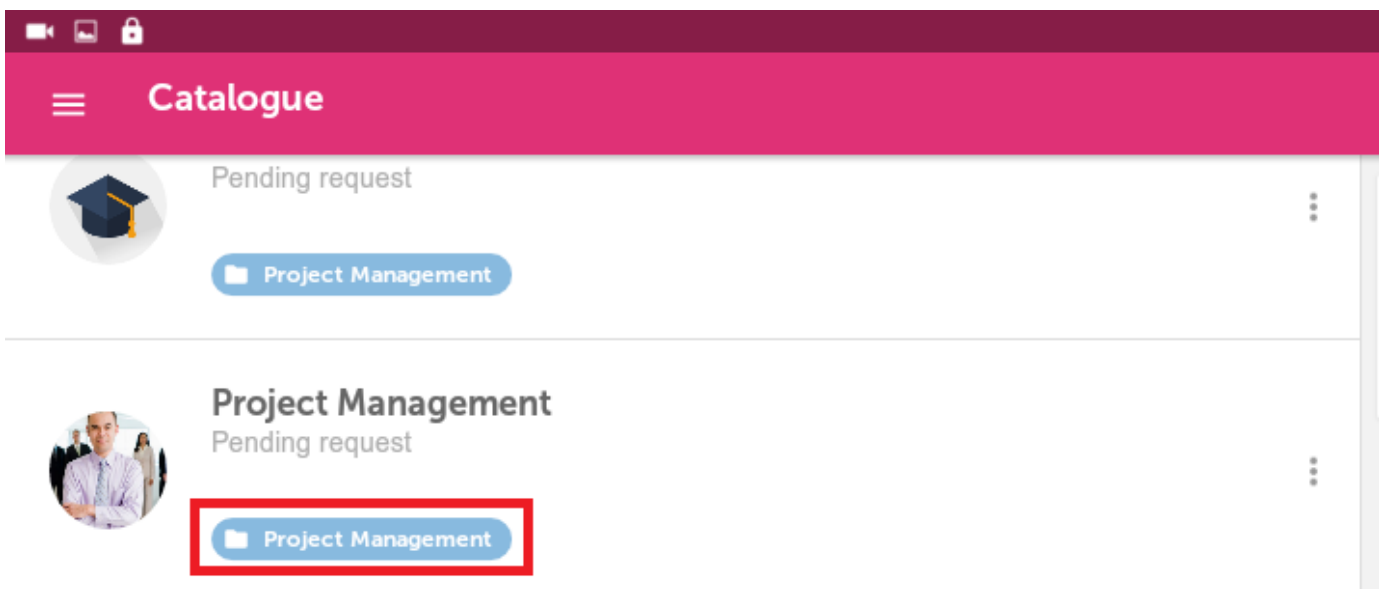
5.2 Enrolment in a course (Mobile)

By clicking on the icon  in the course, you will view a menu in which you can request enrolment or enrol on that course directly, according to the course enrolment policy.





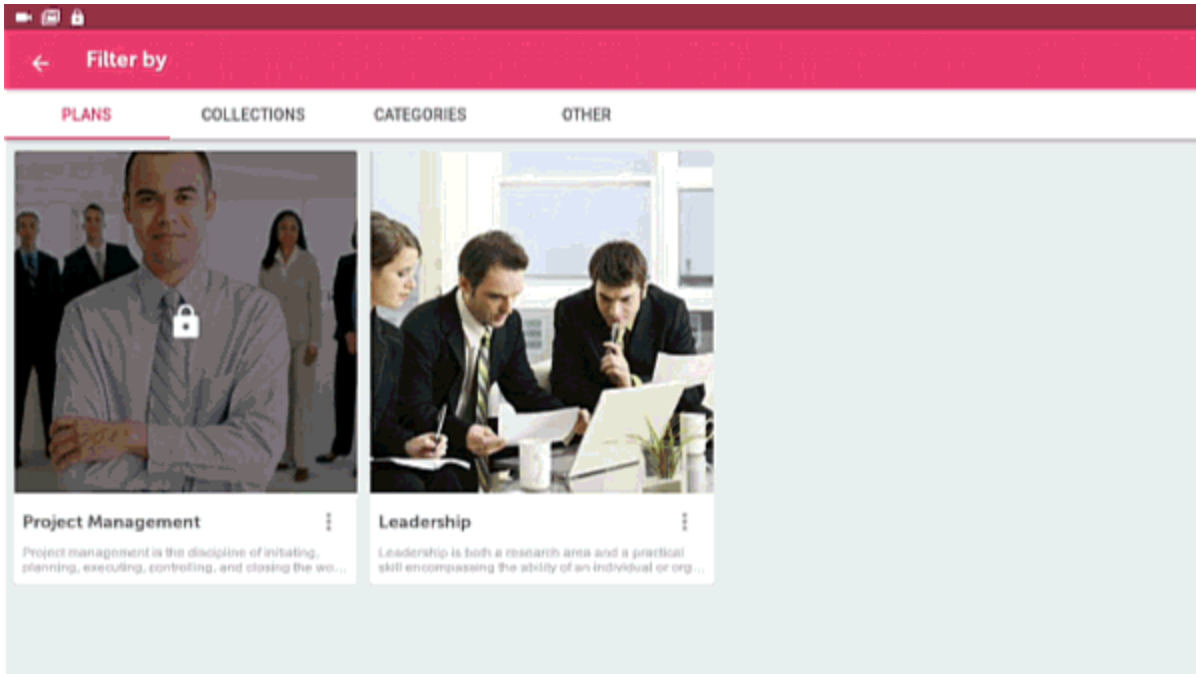
5.3 Plans in the catalogue (Mobile)

A plan is a set of courses that makes up a training itinerary for a group of students. In the **learningCloud Mobile Catalog** it's easy to tell if a course belongs to a plan thanks to an informational label.



Enrolling in a Plan

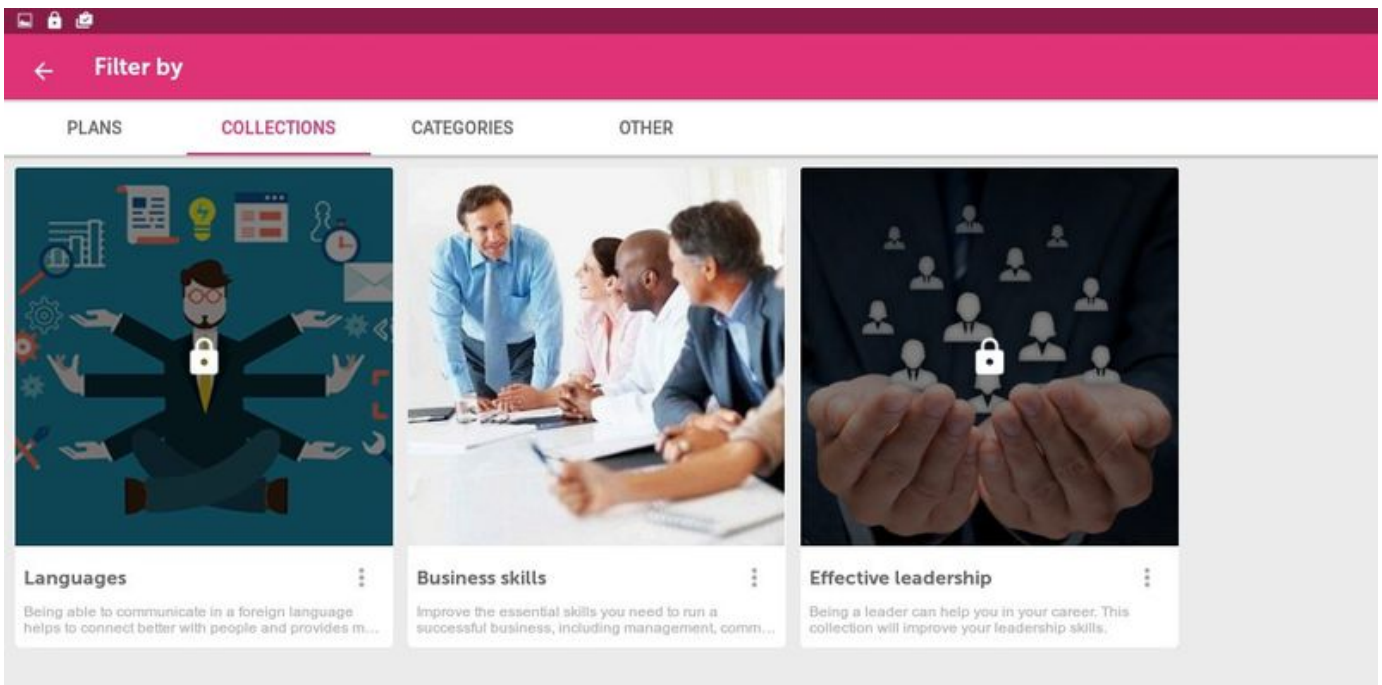
There are plans that have open registration. Other plans require you to apply to enroll. To enroll or to request to enroll for a plan you need to click the filter button  within the catalog. You can view all plans under the **Plans** tab. By clicking  under the desired plan, you can enroll directly or request to enroll (depending on how the plan is configured).




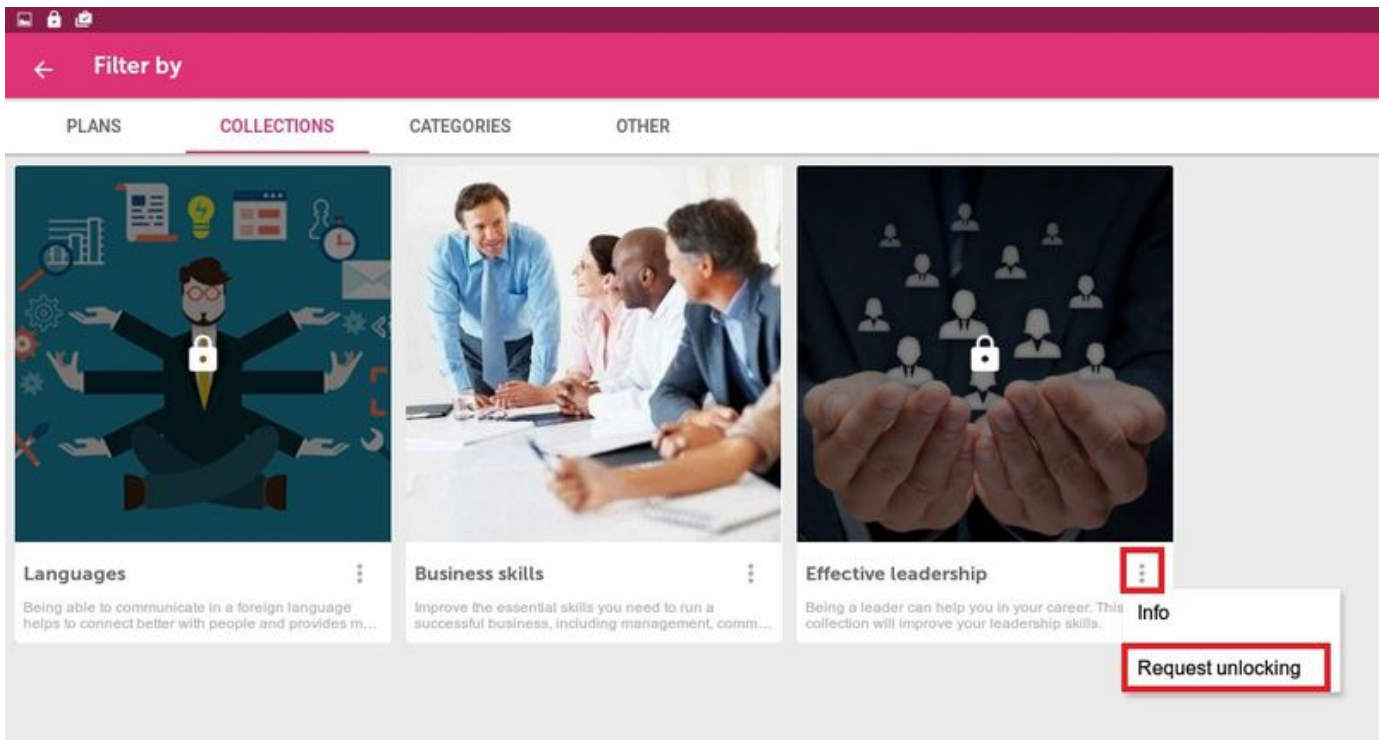
5.4 Collections included in the Catalogue (Mobile)

A collection consists of a group of courses that may be of free access or require the acceptance of your request.

When accessing the **Catalogue**, you can display the existing collections by clicking on the "Collections" filter option. Those collections that require the acceptance of a request are displayed with a lock icon.



To request access to the locked collections, click on the icon , and then click on "Request unlocking". An assistant will help you to perform the steps for making a request.



Additionally, you can request an enrolment in those courses of your interest.

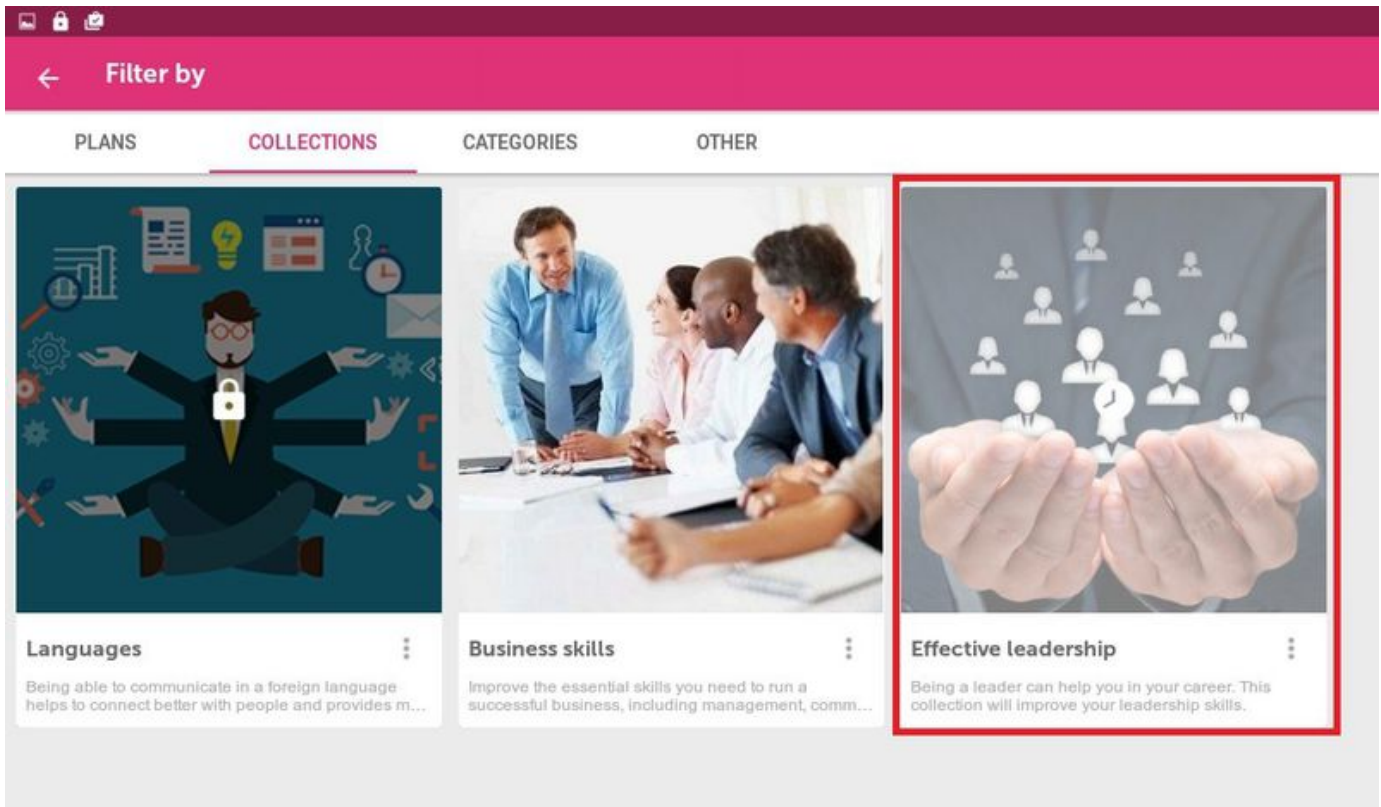
Request unlocking

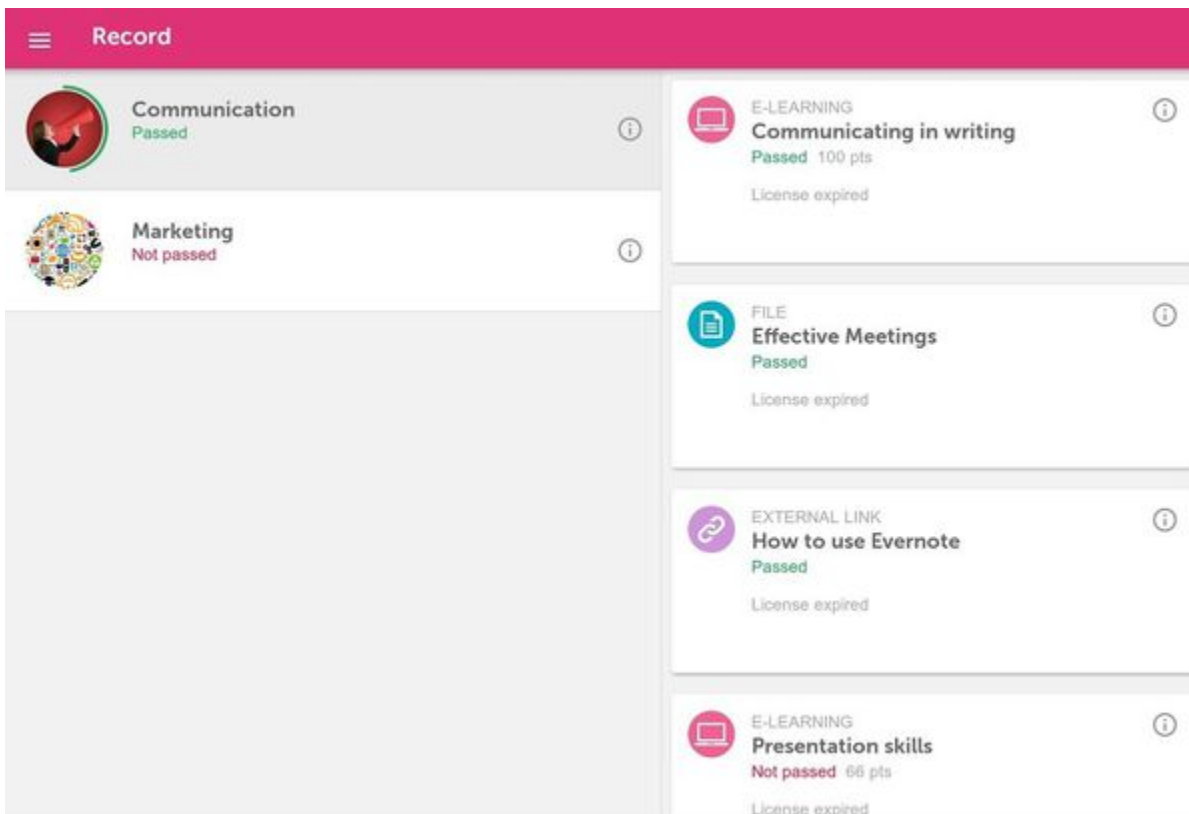

Then, the icon on the collection will be displayed blurred until the training administrator accept your request. When it happens, you can access the courses included in the **Catalogue**.

You will see both the total score of the course and the results of each of session included in the course.

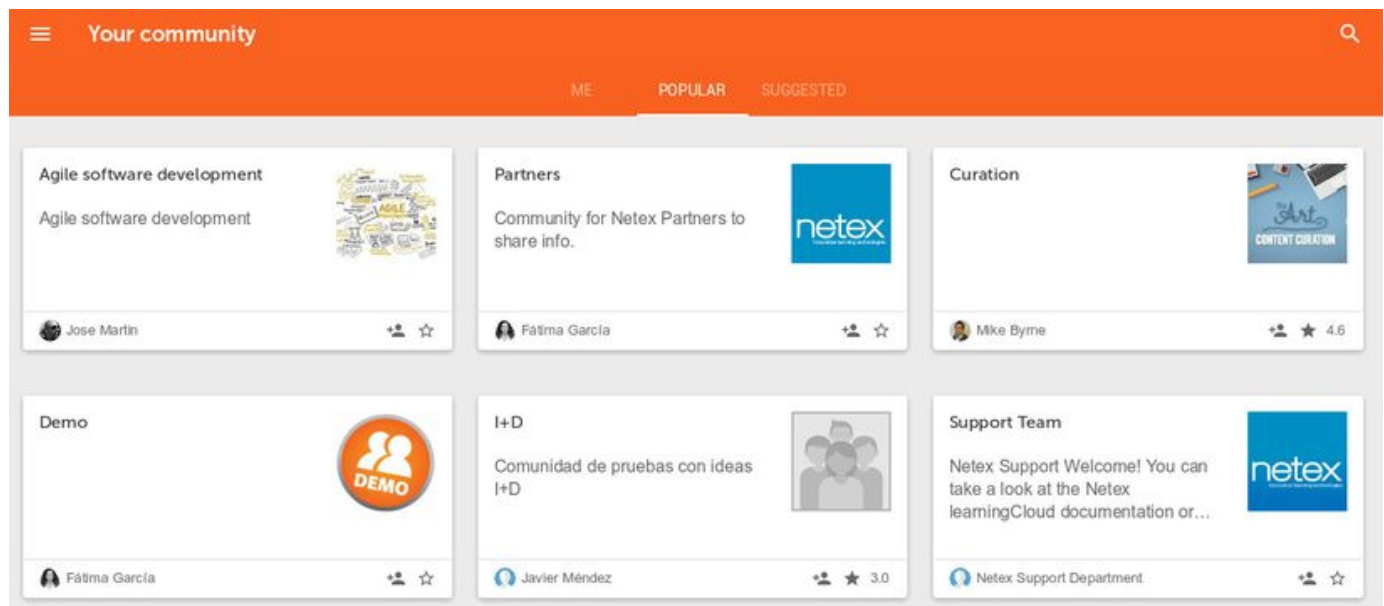

7.1 Accessing Communities (mobile)

By clicking **Your Community** from the main menu, you can access **learningCloud**'s social and collaborative tools.

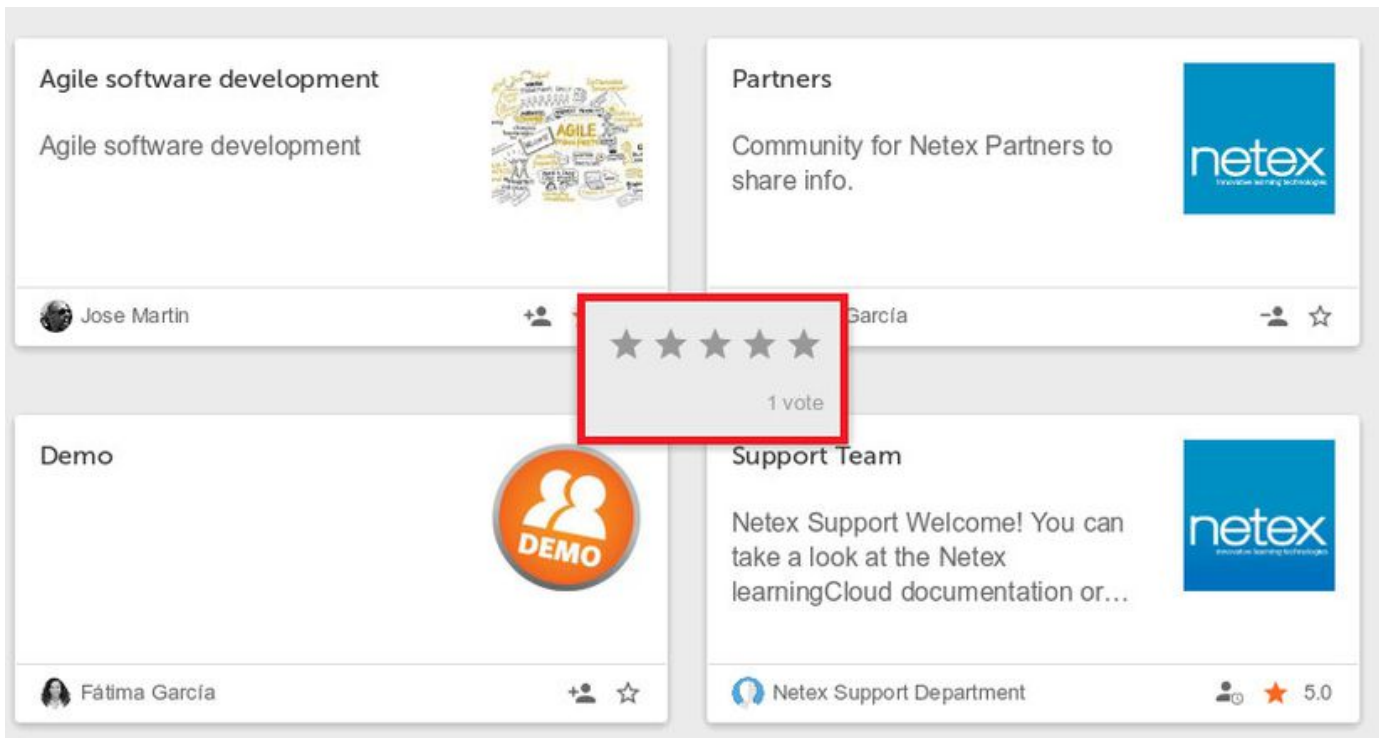


It is easy to locate the community that you want from the start page. Use the search button or consult existing tabs:

- **Mine**, where you can find the communities that you are already a member of.
- **Popular**, where you can view the most highly recommended or highest rated communities.
- **Suggested**, to view communities with themes that match your profile information.

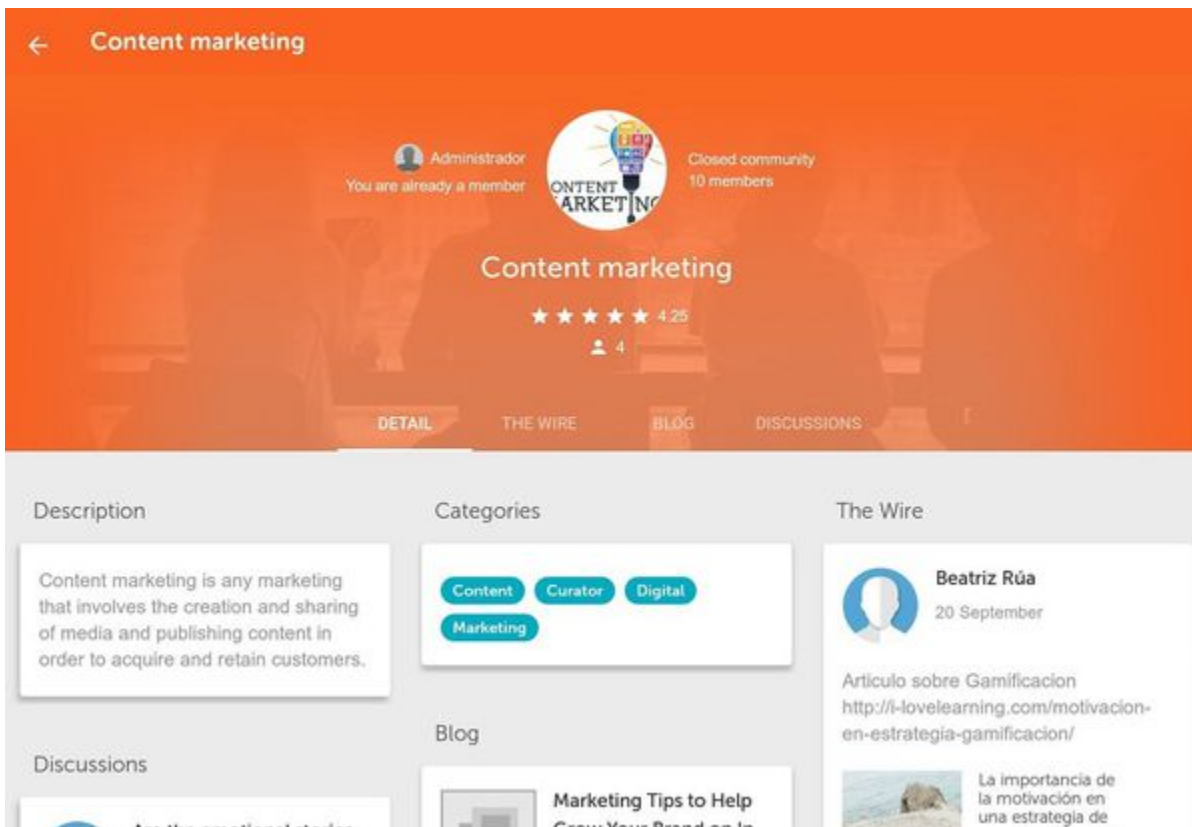
Rating a Community

You can rate communities as you see fit. The average of user ratings and the total number of ratings are shown to introduce the community. This information is used to create the rankings of the most valued communities.



7.2 Community Page (Mobile)

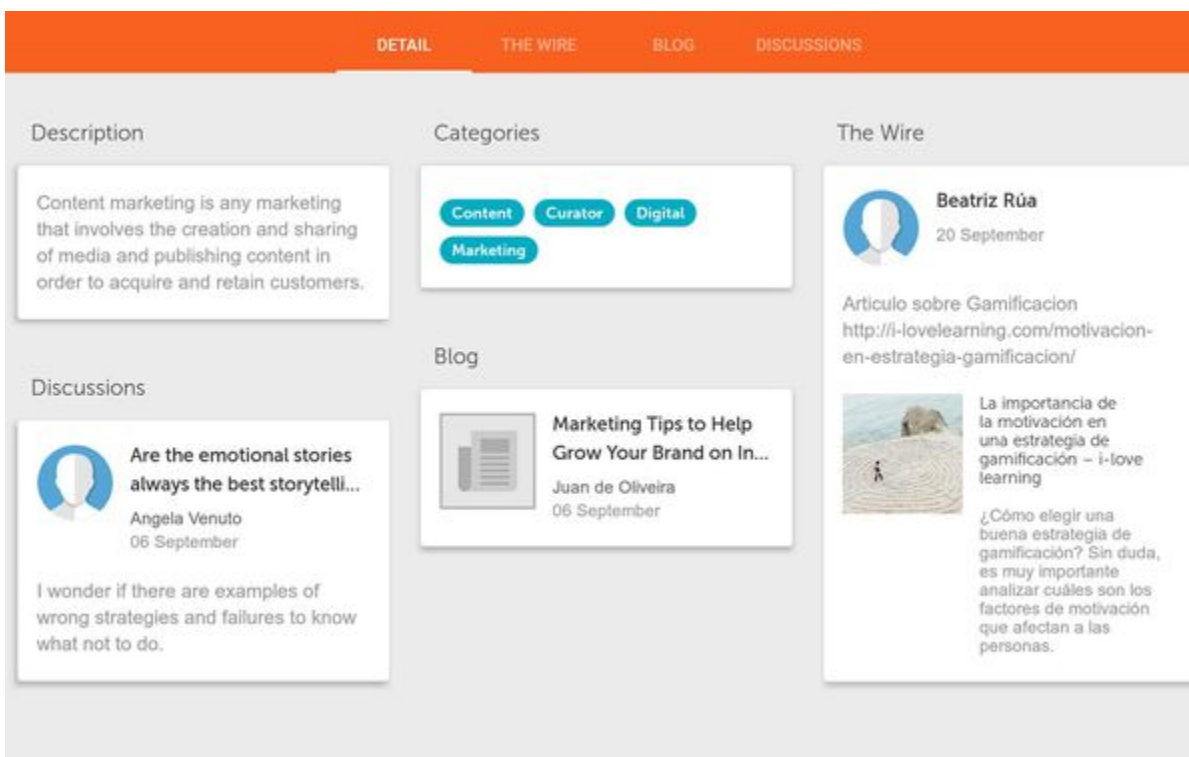
By accessing any of your communities, you can view the community information and access the sections for conversations and shared publications.



On the header of the community page, you can view the administrator, if you are a member of not, the community image, if the image is open or closed, and the number of members. It is also possible to rate the community and view the average rating and number of votes it has received.



There are several tabs on the community page for sections that are available within the community.



On the **Detail** tab, in addition to the **Description** of the community and the **Categories** the community belongs to, you can also view the recent activity for each section of the community with different widgets.

To access the rest of the sections of Your Community and to use advanced options (for example, publishing a blog post), you need to use full access to **learningCloud** from a browser.

Access to Communities that You Are not yet a Member of

If you do not have access to a community that you would like to access, you must request access.


To request access, click the specific button in **Your community**. Depending on your community settings, you can either go directly to the community, or wait until the community administrator accepts your request.

On **The Wire** tab, you can access a communication system which uses microblogging messages to share content with the rest of the community.

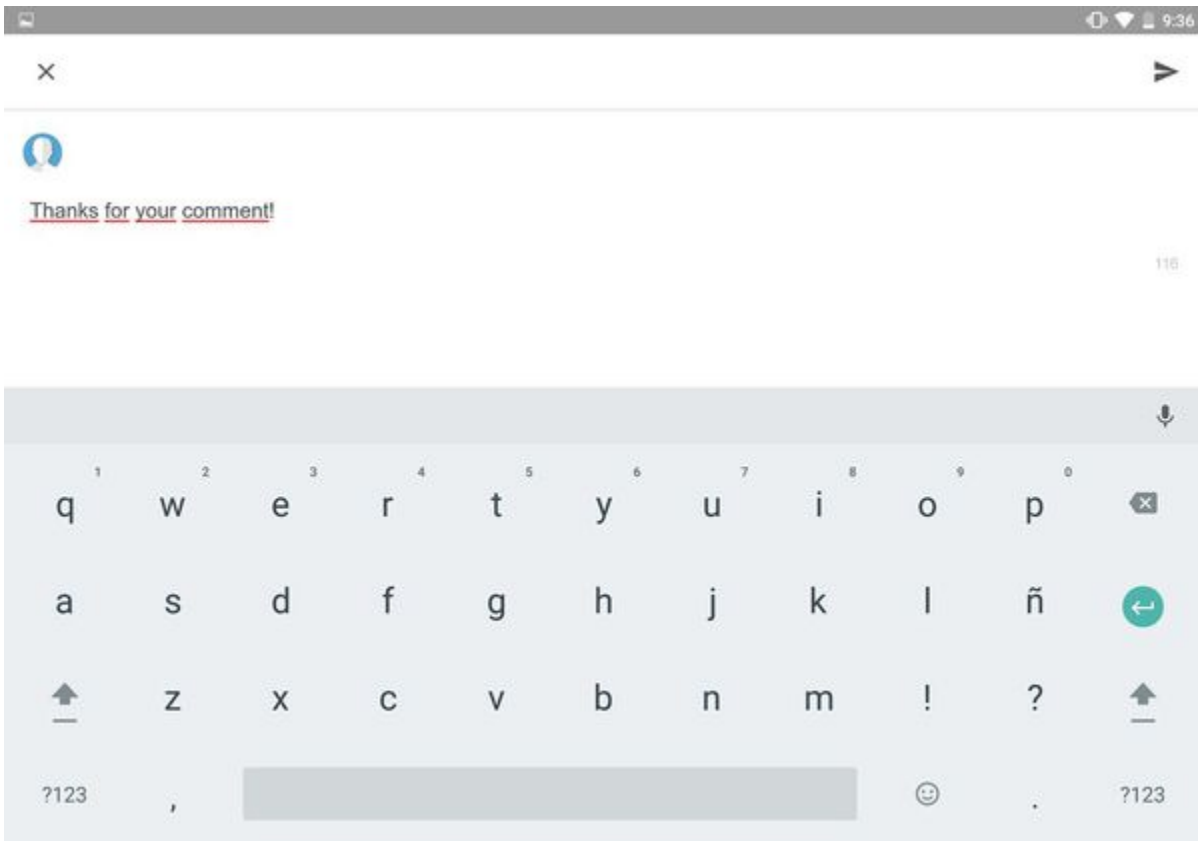


Posting Messages

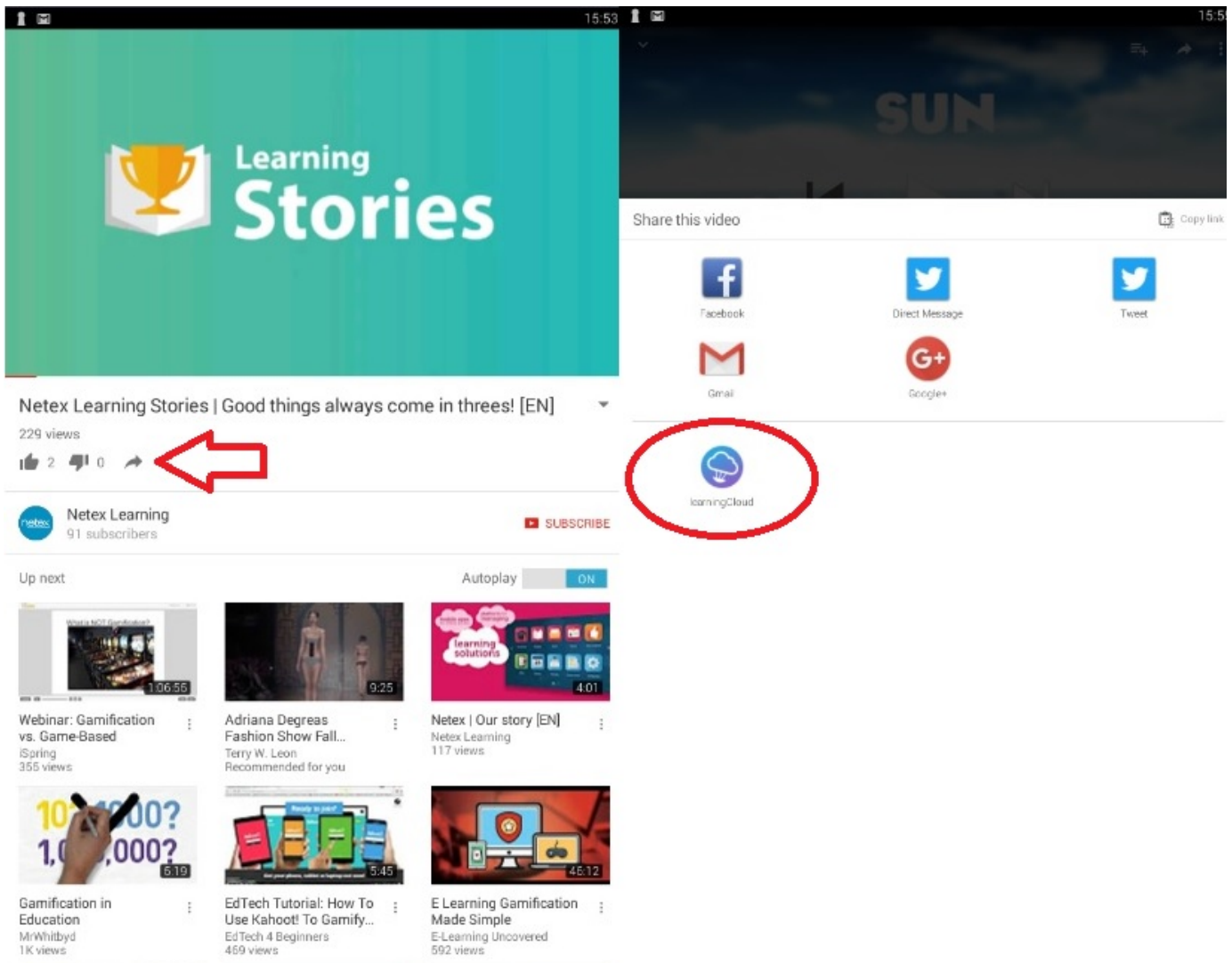

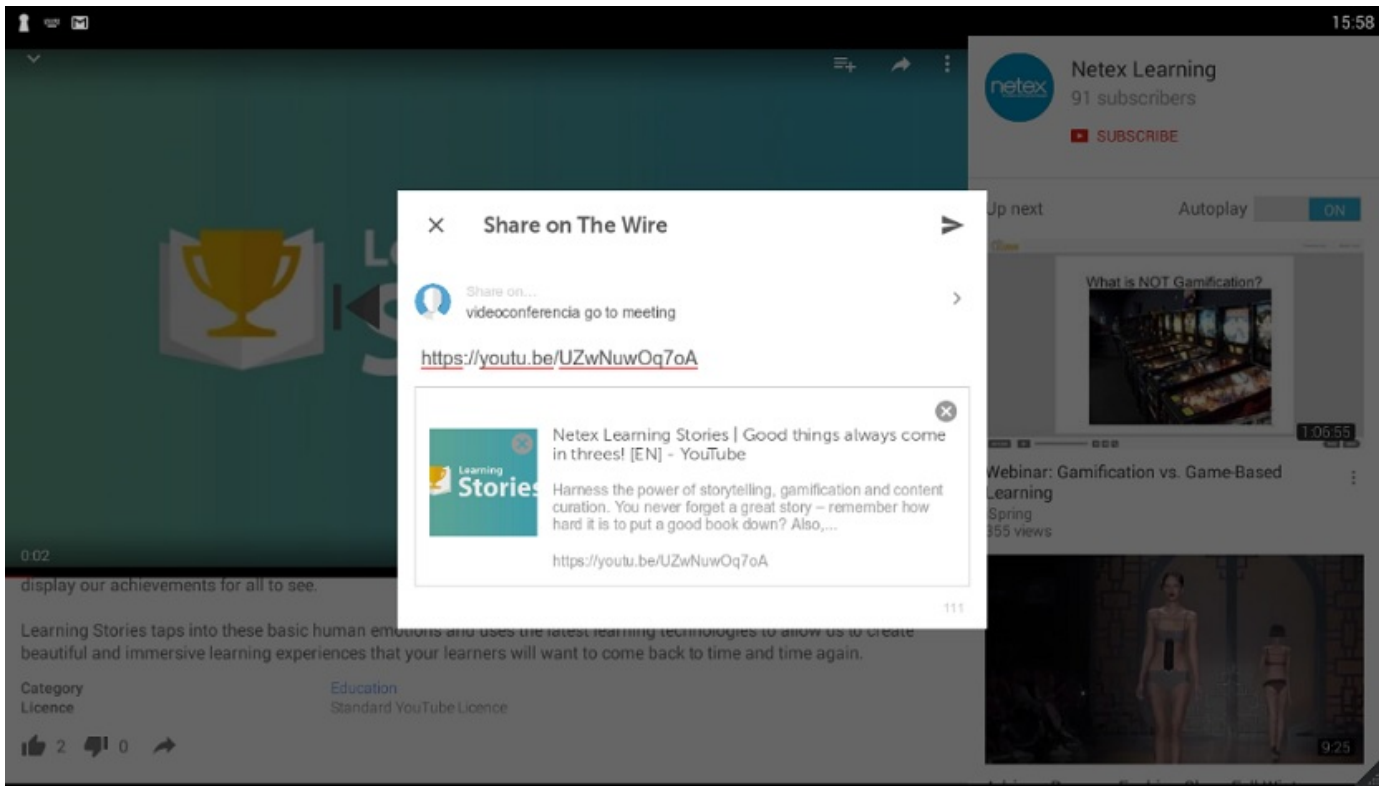
Share with the learning community

- Select the learningCloud app.

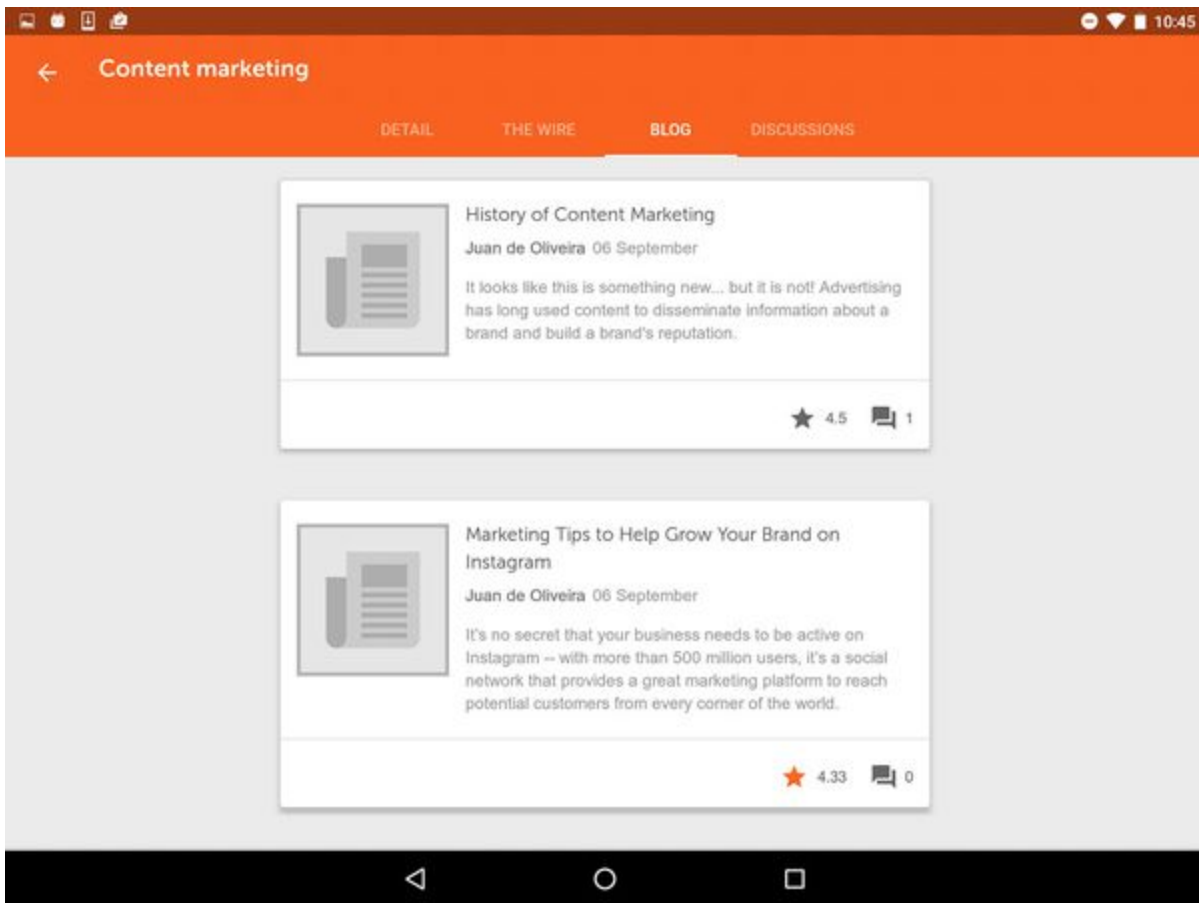

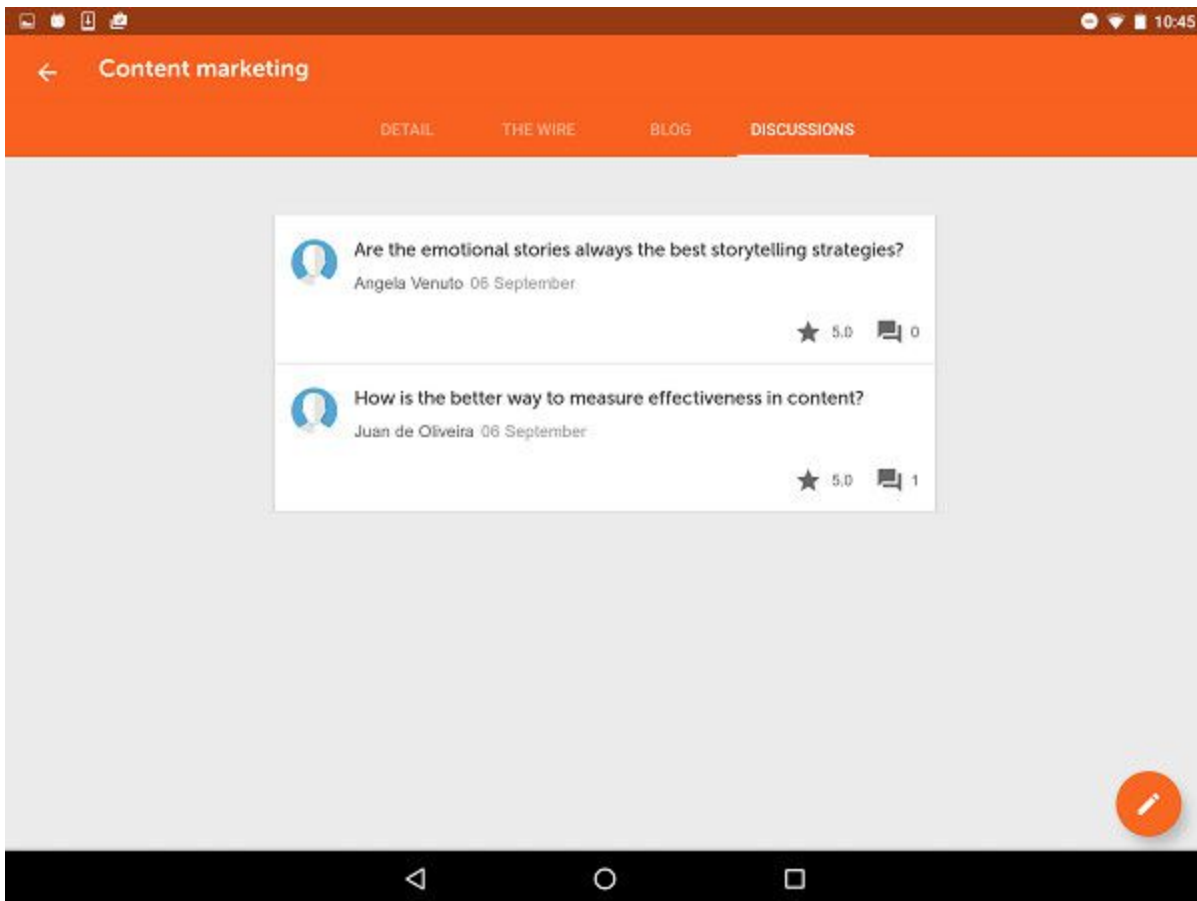
7.4 Blog (mobile) EN

8.1 Notifications (Mobile)

From **More**, in the main menu, you can check the **Notifications** that the training platform administrator wants you to get: inscriptions, exclusions, completions, etc.

8.2 Settings (Mobile)

In the main menu you will find **Settings**, where you can set up **Download only by Wi - Fi** and **View online only Wi - Fi** to reduce data usage via your telephone operator.

8.3 Synchronise (Mobile)

The student progress on the downloaded sessions in **Your training** is updated automatically when the application is launched and when the user has an Internet connection. If the user is not connected to the Internet, they can continue the training that they have already downloaded without losing the data of their progress in the courses.


You can also perform this operation, by clicking on **Synchronise** in the main menu.
